Please make sure that any child who has been sick or had an upset tummy does not return to school for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness.

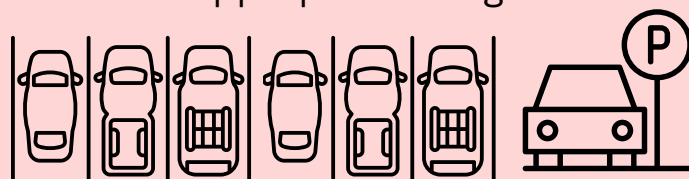
We will contact you should your child be ill at school so make sure we do have up to date contact numbers.

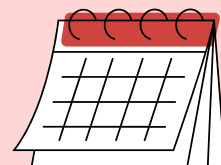
