



Sports Premium Statement 2019/2022

Tavistock has a balance of £16430 Sports Premium funding.

Governors and Educational Financial Services agreed that Sports Funding can be split over the next 3 financial years 2019-2022 to enable school to continue to fund lunchtime Supersportz which enables all children to take part in additional sporting activities beyond the national curriculum requirements.

The Government have announced that PE and Sport Premium will continue in 2019 to 2020 but allocations and guidance will be given to schools later in the financial year.
